Temperaments overall were very good, and despite the lack of shows many handled themselves well, although some did not put all in on the move which placed some exhibits lower than perhaps they would have liked but it is down to what happens on the day.

1 Thomas's Tom Trick's Jocan Tycadno (Swe Imp), wheaten d of good breed type, balanced head, neat erect ears, dark well shaped eye, good bite, ribs carried well back to firm loin, good tail set, low set hocks, moved well fore & aft,

2, Munday's Lentrica Mystic Warrior, dark brindle, good head, well placed ears, good dentition, ample bone, good ribbing, sound quarters, correct coat texture, not giving his best on the move today

1 Shopland's Cherrycrack Moonreakur, brindle d, good head, neat well set ears, used to advantage, strong muzzle & bite, ample bone, ribs carried well back, tail set on, low hocks used well to give strong flowing movement, good textured coat,

2, Byrne's Carradine Howzat Howard, well balance, clean skull, defined stop, good bite & front assembly, held a good topline, low hocks moved well fore & aft,

3, Keeves Seveek Carry On The Dream

1 Coe's Kiwwi A Coestar, balanced head, neat erect ears, dark well set eyes, good pigment, ample bone, well sprung ribs, tail set on, low hocks, well padded feet, moved well fore & aft,

2, Peers & Peers Tweedisle Jaunty Lad, smart d standing but not too happy on the move today, well made head, well set ears, dark eye, good muzzle & bite, ok for bone, ribs well back, sound made quarters, low hocks, well presented jacket,

3, Bateman's Carradine Whiskey Mac

1 & RCC Parker-Tucker' Tom Trick's Incredibly Ilay Of Uniquecottage AW, dark brindle, well furnished head, erect ears, dark well set eye, good muzzle & bite, ok for bone, moderate neck, well sprung ribs, strong 1st & 2nd thigh muscle, low set hocks, well preseted jacket of correct texture, moved with purpose,

2, Dennis, Goddard's & Waites Good Times Ahead With Oudenarde, typical head, good pigment, well set ears, dark eye, strong muzzle & bite, well sprung ribs, held a good topline, well muscled quarters, low set hocks, moved out well fore & aft,

3, Weinberger's Cruzo Copper Coin For Correnie

OD (4-1ab) 1, CC & BOB Harrison's Carradine Whiskey Oscar, dark brindle, correct in skull, well set ears used to advantage, strong muzzle & good sized teeth, correct front assembly, moderate neck, good ribbing, firm loin, tail set on, parallel low set hocks, well muscled quarters used well on the move, great showman, pleased to award him the CC, his 3rd I was told, well done, gave a good performance in the Group,

2, Days Trekhilli Pepperazzi, another dark brindle, larger type, balanced head, dark good ear set, dark eye, good bone, ribs carried well back, sound quarters, well padded feet, moved well fore & aft,

3, Firth, Firth & Firth's Ch Cairngold Chico JW

1 Hiam's Carradine Dottie, dark brindle, still maturing, balanced head neat erect ears, dark well shaped eye, good dentition & ribbing, sound quarters, parallel hocks, new coat coming through, showed well,

2, Bingham's Carradine Bumbling Boris, wheaten again still maturing, well made head, good ear set & pigment, dark eye, good muzzle, ok for bone, ribs carried well back, low set hocks, correct coat texture, not as balanced on the move as 1

1 & BPIB, Goldfinch's Kanawha Never Say Never, 7mth wheaten b, lovely head, good ear set, dark eye with good expression, correct stop. muzzle & bite, well balanced neck & shoulders, ribs carried well back, good tail set, ample bone, well padded feet, moved out well,

2, Osborn & Osborn's Tweslam Be Gin The Magic, another smart pup, attractive well balanced head, neat erect well set ears, good muzzle & bite, ample bone, well ribbed, short firm loin, good topline, sound quarters, well presented jacket,

3, Bubb's Wandris Strike A Light

1 Waugh's Glory Daze At Tribannon, wheaten b, lovely head, neat well set ears, good width of skull, strong muzzle & bite, ample bone, moderate neck, ribs carried well back, strong loin, parallel hocks low set, correct coat texture, moved out well, should do well with maturity

1 Soper's Elitecharm Showgirl, light brindle, balanced head, erect ears well set, dark well shaped eye, strong muzzle & bite, moderate neck, good ribbing, firm loin, well muscled quarters, well padded feet, moved out well,

2 Hiam Carradine Dottie, dark brindle, well made head, good ear carriage, dark eye, ample bone, well sprung ribs, short loin, low set hocks, not as free on the move as 1

YB (4)

1 Keeves Seveek Everlasting Dream, grey brindle, well made head, neat well set ears, dark eye, strong muzzle & correct bite, ribs carried well back, firm loin, low set hocks, well padded feet, good coat texture, moved with aplomb,

2, Osborn & Osborn's Tweslam Days Of Magic, wheaten, attractive well balanced head, good pigment, dark eye, correct bite, ample bone, well ribbed, good tail set, parallel low hocks, well presented jacket, moved freely,

3, McIntyre & McIntyre's Cannwoods Quiet Whisper

1 & CC Hooton & Hughes Penticharm It's My Party, took my eye on entering the ring & did not disappoint on handling, liked her size & overall balance & outline, lovely head, neat ears, dark well shaped eye giving keen expression, correct dentition, good ribbing, firm loin, well muscled quarters, hocks well let down, well padded feet, new jacket coming through of correct texture, moved & showed with verve,

2, Keeves Everlasting Dream, another well balanced b, well proportioned head, erect ears, well set dark eye, ample bone, moderate neck, ribs carried well back to firm loin, parallel low set hocks, good coat texture, moved with purpose,

3, Bubb's Hjhoo's How Easy Hjo Please Me (Swe Imp)

1 Firth, Firth & Firth's Cairngold Chiquitita, b of quality well proportioned head, neat ears, dark eye, lovely expression, good muzzle & bite, correct front assembly, well ribbed, sound quarters, low hocks, good coat texture, sound on the move,

2, Inett, Clayton & Harrison's Carradine Jo, dark brindle, correct head, well shaped eye, strong bite, ample bone, good ribbing, firm loin, well made quarters, today not giving her best on the move,

3, Bateman's Carradine Fizz Bomb

OB (7) quality class a pleasure to judge,

1 & RCC Kinton's Cloverbrook Unbreakable At Woodthorpe, dark brindle, lovely head, neat ears, dark eye giving keen expression, good front assembly, ribs carried well back, strength of loin, muscled quarters, low hocks, well padded feet movement free & true,

2 Yates-Johnson's Pendley Dinah, another dark brindle, excels in breed type, well furnished head, neat ears, dark well set eye, strong muzzle & bite, moderate neck, good topline, short firm loin, low hocks, well padded feet, moved out well

3, Goldfinch's Tycadno Bright Star For Kanawha
