My sympathies to the exhibitors who despite great efforts found it difficult to get the dogs moving as something in the ring was obviously grabbing their attention.

PUPPY DOG (2,2a)

JUNIOR DOG (1,0)

1st Jobling's Ariom Trojan Warrior

Would like to have seen a larger head but has time to mature. Ear and eye placement correct. Good mouth with scissor bite. Well angulated front rear. Good depth of rib. Moved well but a little tight in the rear end.

NOVICE DOG (1,0)

1st Purvis's Mosspur Time and Again

Would like to have seen a broader head. Mouth and teeth correct. Good front with legs tucked under. Decent spring of rib. Moved well when he got going. Coat in good order.

GRADUATE DOG (2,1a)

1st Munday's Lentrica Mystic Warrior

Nice head with good ear and eye placement. Correct moth. Nicely built front and rear with shoulders set correctly. Decent coat. Really needs to settle when on the move. (RBD & RBIS)

LIMIT DOG (2,0)

1st Miller's Cornton Fyne Fettle

Good strong head with good mouth. Front a bit wide, good lay of shoulders into deep rib. Good rear end, strong loin and well-muscled rear end. Well angulated rear giving plenty of drive. Jacket in good order.

2nd Lamb and Saltmarsh Birslaw Dark Charmer for Macmoon Sh.Cm.

Good head with correct mouth. Good front end but not as strong in the rear end which showed on the move. Rear movement a bit close. Coat in good order.

OPEN DOG (2,1a)

1st Lamb and Saltmarsh Birslaw Come Dancing with Macmoon OSW,JW, Sh Cm, Sh Cex.

I Judged this dog before and he just missed out to a very good dog. However today was his for the top honours. Good strong head with good mouth. Nice front, good lay of shoulders into deep rib. Good rear end, strong loin and well-muscled. Well angulated rear giving plenty of drive. Jacket in good order.(BD & BIS)

VETERAN DOG/BITCH (2,1a)

1st Lamb and Saltmarsh

Renshaw There and Back Again Under Macmoon Sh Cm VW IRVETCH

Eleven-year-old dog who seemed to enjoy his day. Nice head with correct bite. Good reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Good deep ribs. Well angulated rear which gave him the drive to get round the ring. (BVIS)

PUPPY BITCH (4,1a)

1st Waugh's Glory Daze at Tribannon

Very feminine looking bitch. Good head with a nice expression from correctly set ears and eyes. Correct mouth. Good front, deep ribs. Well angulated rear. Coat thick and harsh. Difficult to judge movement as she needs to settle on the move. (BBP & BPIS)

2nd Percy's Winetta Frankly My Dear

Preferred the head of the first but otherwise many of the same attributes as the first. Again movement difficult to assess as wasn't settled on the move.

3rd Purvis's Springtime Rose

JUNIOR BITCH (2,0)

1st Jobling's Ariom Full of Sass

Good head and mouth. Well placed ears and eyes. Nice front. Deep ribs. A little tight in the rear end but moved well round the ring.

2nd Shannon & Storr's Doonrae Rebel Rebel Among
Brenndarcy

I actually preferred this to the first but she adopted the prone position and would not move for her handler. Lovely head. Good mouth with correct dentition. Good front and well laid shoulder. Deep rib and well angulated rear. Could be one to watch if she moves.

GRADUATE BITCH (2,2a)

LIMIT BITCH (3,1a)

1st Miller's Cornton Fyne Hope

Nice bitch with a lovely head and expression from neat ears and well-set eyes. Good front, reach of neck on a pair of well-set shoulders. Deep ribs with well angulated rear with tail set on top. Moved around the ring with ease Coat could have been trimmed shorter on the shoulder area? (BB & BOS)

2nd Munday's Lentrica Dolly Mixture at Carernwil

Good head and mouth. Slightly wider in the front but with good shoulder placement and deep rib. Rear end is well angulated but a bit tight. Coat in good condition. Moved OK.

OPEN BITCH (4, 2a)

1st Lund's Cairngold Brandy Snap by Jorvikan

Nice bitch with a lovely head and expression from neat ears and well-set eyes. Good front, reach of neck on a pair of well-set shoulders. Deep ribs with well angulated rear with tail set on top. Moved around the ring with ease. (RBB)

2nd Dolan's Whispers at Dawn at Glenrood

Difficult to separate first and second as both had many of the same attributes. They could easily change places but in the end, I just felt the rear movement of first tipped the balance.
