# Post Graduate Dog (2)

1. Parker Tucker's Uniquecottage Grey Shiso

3 year old grey brindle. Masculine head with definite stop, well placed ears. Good length of neck and lay of shoulder and adequate forechest. A level topline and good length of leg with a set of hocks which gave this dog his movement of drive and balance. **BD and BIS** 

2. Sinclair's Tycadno Quick Shot

2 year old wheaten. Has a lovely head and typical Cairn expression, correct bite and well set on ears. Good lay of shoulder and level topline which he kept on the move. Quite long in the loin. Showed well but just lacks that "umph" to get the best in his movement.

#### Open Dog (4, 2 A)

1. Roberts' Cannwood Moonlight Shadow

Just over 3 years old wheaten. Alert boy, full of presence with lovely head and good ear set and stop. Good length of neck and lay of shoulder giving good forward action. Level topline and well appointed rear angulation. Coat in excellent condition. **RBD** 

2. Inett's Carradine My Way Lenny

18 month old grey brindle. Pleasing head but a narrow front, good length of leg and well let down hocks, tail set nice and shown in good coat.

# Special Beginners D or B (4)

1. Metcalf Sault's Cannwood Can't Get Enough

4 year old wheaten bitch. Lovely head and deep hazel eyes, good stop and a super expression. Level topline and well angulated at the rear. Shown in a well furnished full coat.

#### **Minor Puppy Bitch (1)**

1. Parker Tucker's Uniquecottage Sorrel

Just 6 months old, wheaten with lovely dark points and in absolute wonderful coat for such a baby. Well proportioned head and correct bite. Nice length of leg and overall balance, moved well and sound.

# Puppy Bitch (4, 1A)

1. Dolan's Glenrood It Has To Be Me

A lovely wheaten/red. Super head with definite stop, well set on ears. Nicely proportioned puppy who stood well on the table. Good length of back to loin and well let down hocks which made her well balanced overall. Excellent coat for youngster and well presented, pleased to award her **BPIS**.

2. Firth's Glenrood Silent Whisperer at Cairngold
Another lovely wheaten baby, built a little slighter than 1<sup>st</sup>. Pleasing head and eye, good lay of shoulder, level topline and correct tail set. Not so outgoing as litter sister, but showed well.

Dark brindle with good head, nice white teeth and kind eye giving her that mischievous "Cairn look". Good lay of shoulder and level topline which she kept on the move, a little shy today.

# **Novice Bitch (2)**

1. Waites' Svendalens Skye Lantern

20 month old grey brindle. Well proportioned head and good dentition. Well set neat ears and good lay of shoulder and leg length and a level topline with a tail set that was just "right". A sound mover with coat of good quality that completed the picture. **RBB** 

2. Parker Tucker's Uniquecottage Dark Tansy 8 month old dark brindle, still a baby but has a super head and correct bite. Good rear angulation but needs to tighten up when on the move.

#### Post Graduate Bitch (7)

1. Osborn's Be Gin Again at Tweslam

Grey brindle 3 year old. Super head and excellent proportion of ear set with correct shape eye. A nice flow of shoulder to wither leading to a level topline which she kept on the move, the right length of leg to display her hocks giving her a well balanced movement. Coat well presented with lots of ring presence and pleased to award her **BB**, **RBIS and BOS** 

2. Parkin's Svendalens Dancing Queen

A quality dark brindle, 2 years old. Very alert and making the most of her surroundings. Lovely head and expression, good stop and dentition. Good forechest and length of leg. A level topline, which she kept whilst being shown. In good coat and well presented.
