I would like to thank the SCTC Committee for inviting me to judge the 86th Club's Championship Show. I was very pleased with my entry, thank you exhibitors for giving me the opportunity to go over your Cairns. I was generally happy with the quality of the Cairns. Quite a number with nice head and expression, good stop and scissor bite. One with light eyes in a dark head and one with very dark eyes in a pale head, both spoiling the expression. Generally good angulation front and behind. Good tailsets. My winners reflect the balance that I like in a Cairn. Occasionally I saw a tendency of losing length of leg which disturbs that balance. As far as movement is concerned please breed away from narrow gait behind which affects good parallel movement, reaching out in front and with drive behind. A big thank you to my stewards Sharon Confue and Amanda-Jayne Davey for their helpful ring procedures with a smile!

Minor Puppy Dog (1,0)

1. Lucas & Tobutt's Carradine Sir Percival. 9 month old red puppy dog. Nice head and expression. Good eyes and ears. Prefer a bit more stop. Already quite a good coat. Moved quite well. A bit narrow behind.

Puppy Dog (1,0a)

1. Percy's Ariom Northern Dancer With Winetta. 11 months old red puppy dog with very nice harsh coat. Nice head and expression with good stop, ears and eyes. Sufficient forechest. Nice neck flowing into shoulders. Good angulation front and behind and a balanced outline. A good mover when settled. A bit narrow behind. **BPIS**.

Junior Dog (3,0a)

1. Felters and Rumens' Landbuck Sabrage. 17 month old wheaten brindle. Sturdy youngster of balanced proportions. Good Coat. Nice head and inquisitive expression. Typical dark points. Nice neck flowing into shoulders. Well angulated front and behind and nice outline. Good length of loin. Good bone. Moved well when settled, parallel front and behind. **Dog CC, BOS and RBIS**. 2. Lamb and Saltmarsh' Tycadno Shining Star Around Macmoon JW. 17 months old wheaten dog of a more stylish type. Would wish him to body up a bit. Good forechest. Nice head and expression. Good angulation front and behind. Nice overall outline. Moved well. 3. Rose's Carradine All Ways A Chance.

Novice Dog (1,0a)

1. Ortolano's Svendalens Max In A Million. 22 months old grey brindle dog of good size. Nice head and keen expression. Well built. Good proportions. Would prefer somewhat more bone. Moved efficiently.

Undergraduate Dog (3,0a)

1. Munday's Furythor Reluctant Villain. Dark brindle dog, 18 months old. Nice head and expression. Good stop. Good neck flowing into shoulders. Well angulated. Harsh coat. Moved well.

2. Sinclair & Tothill's Tycadno Quick Shot. 2 year old wheaten dog of good proportions. Good head and expression. Nice outline, level back. Good coat. Moved well, but a bit pinning in front. 3. Rose's Carradine All Ways A Chance.

1. Ortolano's Svendalens Max In A Million. 2. Sinclair & Tothill Tycadno Quick Shot. 3. Morley's Kanawha Spy Man.

Graduate Dog (2,0a)

1. McIntyre's Castleline Lucas Of Macantsaoir. 19 months old wheaten dog. Would like him slightly bigger. Good head with eager expression. Would prefer more forechest. Good coat. Level back and good angulation. Good length of leg. Moved well but with an excited tail carriage. 2. Parker-Tucker's Uniquecottage Grey Sisho. 2 year old dark brindle dog. Nice head and expression. Well proportioned. Would prefer a bit more forechest. Good coat coming through. Did not cooperate with handler on the move.

Post Graduate Dog (2,0a)

1. Thomas & Jones' Tycadno New Tricks. 3 year old nice wheaten dog with good bone. Nice head and expression. Stands well over forepaws, sufficient forechest. Very nice full coat. Level back, well angulated front and behind. Good tailset and carriage. Moved efficiently. 2. McIntyre's Macantsaoir Celtic Warrior. Grey brindle upstanding dog of 2½ years with a good coat. Good head and keen expression. Level back and good tailset. Moved well but a bit loose in front.

Limit Dog (6,1a)

1. Lucas & Tolbutt's Seveek Country Lad. 4 year old dark brindle dog with good proportions. Nice head and expression. Good coat. Good bone. Level back and good tailset. Good angulation behind. Slightly lower in front when standing. Moved well and parallel. 2. Morley's Kanawha Spy Man. Another nice dark brindle dog of 5 years. Nice head and expression. Good angulations. Good tailset. Moved well and so much better than in SBD. 3. Byrne's Carradine Howzat Howard.

Open Dog (5,0a)

1. Thomas' Tycadno Magic Man. Overall very well balanced 3 year old wheaten dog of good size. Nice head and expression. Sufficient forechest. Level back and good tailset. Good angulation front and behind. A nice outline. Moved well up and down and parallel. Moved efficiently sideways.

Reserve Dog CC. 2. Ballingers' Ch Cloverbrook Game Set Nmatch. A slightly bigger size grey brindle dog of almost 3 years old. Nice head and expression with typical dark points. Sufficient forechest. Level back and good tailset and carriage. Good angulation behind. Moved well and efficiently. Preferred balance of 1. 3. Yates-Johnson's Ch Pendley Seafarer.

Special Veteran Dog or Bitch (7-9 years inclusive) (6,2a)

1. Smith's Cannwood Misty Dawn At Gethlee. A very nice wheaten bitch of 9 years old. Pretty head and nice expression. Sufficient forechest. Good balanced angulation. Nice length of leg. Nice short tail. Moved very well for her age. **BVIS** 2. Dolan's Ch Whispers At Dawn At Glenrood. A 7 year old well balanced wheaten bitch of good confirmation. Lovely head and expression. Coat in very

good condition. Moved quite well. 3. Birselow Come Dancing With Macmoon OSW JW ShCEx ShCM.

Minor Puppy Bitch (1,0a)

1. Waugh's Tribannon Rose Pixie. Very promising wheaten bitch of 6 months old. Nice head and expression with typical dark points. Good neck flowing into shoulders. Well balanced angulation front and behind. Level back. Good forechest. Good bone. Already a good coat for her age. Moved well and parallel when settled.

Puppy Bitch (3,1a)

1. Dolan's Glenrood It Has To Be Me. Nice upstanding red puppy bitch, 10 months old. Nice head and expression. Good neck flowing into shoulders. Good length of leg. Well balanced angulation front and behind. Sufficient forechest. Level back. Good coat. Moved well and parallel. 2. Parker-Tuckers's Uniquecottage Sorrel. Pretty wheaten puppy with typical dark points, 8½ months old. Nice head and expression. Slightly lower on the leg than 1. Well angulated. Nice full coat for such a youngster. Would like a better ear carriage on the move. Moved well.

Junior Bitch (6,0a)

1. Felters and Rumens' Landbuck Amethyst. Very pretty wheaten brindle bitch, 17 months old. A balanced outline is what stands out at first glance. Lovely head with mischievous expression. Typical dark points Sufficient forechest. Good neck flowing into shoulders. Level back. Well angulated front and behind. Good tailset. Moved well and efficiently. 2. Firth's Cairngold Claim To Fame. Another very nice dark brindle bitch of 14 months old. Nice head and expression. Nice neck flowing into shoulders. Good forechest. Balanced angulation front and behind. Level back and good tailset. Moved well and parallel. Recovered quickly from being spooked. 3. Tribannon Angel's Kiss.

Maiden Bitch (1,0a)

1. Parker-Tucker's Uniquecottage Dark Tansy. Nice 8½ months old dark brindle bitch of good construction. Nice head and expression. Good coat. Well balanced angulation front and behind. Good tailset. Moved well when settled.

Novice Bitch (3,1a)

1. Ortolano's Svendalens Pumpkin Pie. Attentive 23 months old dark brindle bitch. Would prefer a slightly darker eye. Good bite. Good length of leg. Straight front. Stands well over forepaws. Level back. Harsh coat. Good tailset. Would prefer a slightly lower hock. Moved quite well, parallel in front. Well presented. 2. Saich's Lindcoly Sweetest Maid Marion. A 13 months old red bitch. Would prefer a stronger head. Good bite. Standing well over forepaws. Good forechest. Good angulation front and behind. Moved well but a bit narrow behind.

Graduate Bitch (3,0a)

1. Jones & Thomas' Castleline Seren At Tycadno. Nice wheaten bitch of 19 months old. Lovely head and expression. Sufficient forechest. Balanced outline. Good angulation front and behind. Level back. Moved well. 2. Thomas & Jones' Tycadno Dark Star. Another nice grey brindle bitch of 3 years old. Nice head and expression with typical dark points. Good forechest. Stands well over forepaws. Well angulated. Moved well but a bit loose in front. Would prefer her to use her tail more while moving. 3. Lindcoly Times Of Trouble.

Post Graduate Bitch (3,2a)

1. Osborn's Be Gin Again At Tweslam. Nice 3 year old upstanding grey brindle bitch of good quality. Nice head and expression. Good stop. Sufficient forechest. Nice length of leg. Good angulation front and behind. Moved well when settled.

Limit Bitch (11,3a)

1. Shannon & Storr's Brenndarcy Witches Promise. Very lively feminine red grey brindle bitch of 2½ years old. Lovely head and expression. Sufficient forechest. Balanced outline. Good coat. Level back. Good angulations. Good tailset. Moved well with ease. 2. Dolan's Glenrood Midnight Spell. Another nice dark grey brindle upstanding bitch, 3½ years old. Good head and expression. Good forechest. Nice neck flowing into shoulders. Level back. Good tailset. Well angulated. Good tailset. Moved well. 3. Cloverbrook Shining Star.

Open Bitch (6,3a)

1. Hooton & Hughes' Penticharm It's My Party. Excellent wheaten brindle feminine bitch of almost 7 years. Appealing balanced outline overall. Lovely head and expression with dark points. Nice neck flowing into shoulders. Well angulated. Level topline. Nice tailset. Very good coat in immaculate order. Moved very well, parallel and with energy and drive. Not exaggerated in any part. Pleased to award her **Bitch CC and BIS**. 2. Percy's N/SE/DK Ch Stenrosets Kajsa Kavat (Imp Swe) NJV-21 NV-24 DKV-24. Another well balanced feminine dark brindle bitch of almost 5 years old. Lovely head and expression. Good forechest. Level back. Good tailset. Good angulation front and behind. Moved effortlessly. **Reserve Bitch CC**. 3. Lindcoly Phantom Menace.
