Class 1 - Baby Puppy Dog Or Bitch (3,2)

1st - Mr G Thomas “Tycadno Starburst” – 5 month old Boy in good coat, alone in his class but did very well, nice head with nice expression, good bite nice big teeth, neat well-placed ears, moved well in profile, driving well from behind, a very promising youngster – Best Baby Puppy In Show.

Class 2 - Veteran Dog Or Bitch (5,1) A very Nice Class of Lovely Veterans.

1st Miss J H Smith “Cannwood Misty Dawn At Gethlee” 9 year old Cream Bitch in great condition for her age, nice feminine expression, Scissor bite, neat ears, harsh coat, good bone neat feet, moved soundly from all directions, handler worked well to get the best out of her – Best Veteran In Show.

2nd Mr R Goud “Lentrica Liberty Bell” 7 year old Red Brindle Bitch, showy girl very Alert and keen, liked her a lot, nice head, Scissor Bite, good reach of neck, harsh coat which were so short at base of neck gives the look of fat rolls when standing but she isn't fat it's just how the hair sits, moved well from all directions.

1st Ms J & Mr B Lamb & Saltmarsh “Tycadno Shining Star Around Macmoon JW” 17 month old Cream Boy, very handsome expression, good stop, good bite, Nice eyes, neat ears, good reach of neck, level topline, good ribs, and bone, nice harsh double coat, moved round the ring well, worked well with his handler to win the class.

2nd Miss P J A Rose “Carradine All Ways A Chance” 17 month old Red Brindle, liked him a lot, nice expression, Scissor Bite, good stop, nice reach of neck, level topline, moved round the ring well and worked brilliantly with his handler, just pipped by coat which is harsh but lacking, will come through.

1st Miss J & Mrs J Sinclair & Tothill “Tycadno Quick Shot” 2 year old Wheaton/Cream with Masculine head, good stop, great bite, nice expression, good harsh coat at correct length, good spring of ribs, level top line, neat feet, moved well in profile, his maturity won the class.

2nd Miss S C & Miss E S Munday “Furythor Reluctant Villain” 18 month old Brindle boy, great bite with large teeth, good stop, level top line, harsh coat, neat feet, good tail carriage moved well in profile, good drive from behind, just pipped by maturity.

Class 8 – Limit Dog (4,2)

1st Miss R & Mr I Lucas & Tobutt “Seveek Country Lad” 4-year-old grey brindle boy with Masculine Head, good stop, large teeth, correct scissor bite, good bone, good reach of neck on to well laid shoulders, well sprung ribs, level top line, neat feet with strong pads, good tail set. Moved well and freely around the ring, his owner works hard to get the best out of him and was pleased to award him 1st in this class then Reserve Best Dog.

2nd Mrs V L Bryne “Carradine Howzat Howard” 5 year Dark Brindle Boy I have judged this dog before successfully a few years ago, but sadly he has been spooked on the table recently the owner explained and I was unable to go over his head and front. He has a Masculine head, well sprung ribs, level topline, neat feet, good harsh coat, moved well round the ring and has a lovely profile.

Class 9 – Open Dog (1)

1st Mr G Thomas “Tycadno Magic Man” 3-and-a-half-year-old Wheaton Male beautifully presented, handsome masculine head, great bite, good stop, nice eyes, small pointed ears, good reach of neck onto well laid shoulders, well sprung ribs, level topline, good tail set, good bone, neat feet with strong pads, strong well muscled thighs, harsh double at correct length. He moved well and freely around the ring and has a such show presence; he is cheeky showing the “active & game” characteristics of the breed was pleased to award him Best Dog and Best of Breed, definitely one to watch – well done.

2nd Mrs A & Mr A Osborn “Be Gin Again At Tweslam” 3 year old grey brindle girl, feminine head, great bite, good stop, neat ears, good reach of neck onto well laid shoulders, level topline, nice bone, good harsh coat, moved well round the ring, kept her handler working, loved her cheekiness and ring presence, very nice.

3rd Mr R Goud “Breezy Kingussie Molly Connell”

Class 16 – Limit Bitch (5,1)

1st Mrs A & Mr A Osborn “Tweslam Be Gin The Magic” 4 year old rich red bitch with pretty feminine head, good bite with big teeth, good stop, good reach of neck on to well laid shoulders, good spring of ribs, level topline, neat feet, thick pads, moved well from all directions winning her the class, was definite contender for top awards, very nice Cairn – another to watch.

2nd Miss S C & Miss E S Munday “Furythor Marvel at Me” 3-year-old dark brindle girl, feminine head, strong muzzle, great bite with big teeth. Good reach of neck, level topline, good bone, neat feet, good harsh coat, moved well in profile around the ring and has great drive. Very showy and cheeky keeping her handler on her toes, very nice girl.

3rd Miss J H Smith “Cloverbrook Shining Star Over Gethlee”

Class 17 – Open Bitch (3,2)
