- 1) **Roberts' Ch Cannwood Moonlight Shadow.** Caught my eye as he entered the ring. Beautifully balanced d with a masculine head of good proportions with a good reach of neck into excellent shoulders with a level topline, well angulated rear quarters & correct tailset. He moved with drive & purpose. Handled well & was well presented in a good jacket **DCC/BOB**
- 2) **Felters & Rumens' Ch Landbuck Sabrage** Lovely masculine head with a keen expression. So well balanced with a pleasing outline. Good reach of neck, correct shoulders with a level topline, well set tail & good rear construction. Presented in a good harsh jacket. Good mover who moved with drive. A true showman.

**Minor Puppy Bitch (4)**

- 1) **Parker-Tucker's Uniquecottage Red Ayla** 6 months. Very smart, beautifully balanced red with a lovely feminine head, very good front, topline & rear quarters. Well presented in a tight jacket. So showy & moved with ease. Should have a bright future **BPIB**

2) **Petts' Doonrae Visage** 7 months. Well balanced red with a nice head piece, good in front & rear, shown in full jacket. Lacked the ring presence & confidence of 1 – has time on her side.

#### **Puppy Bitch (3,1)**

1) **Tester's Airytykes Turn Up The Night** Wheaten brindle shown in good coat who presented a nice profile with a lovely feminine head, well laid shoulders, level topline, good rear. Moved & showed steadily. Would like a little more of her.

2) **Saich's Lindcoly Esmerelda** Red brindle. She has a lovely head with nice shoulder placement, show in very full coat which detracted from her overall outline. Needs to settle on the move.

#### **Junior Bitch (4,1)**

1) **Waugh's Tribannon Nancy Lou** Up to size wheaten with a lovely feminine head, straight front, nicely laid shoulders, level topline which she held on the move, with a correct tailset. Moved well in both directions. Presented well in a good coat.

2) **Shannon & Storr's Brenndarcy Supertramp** Nice head & expression with a level topline & correct tailset. Moved & showed well in a good coat.

#### **Graduate Bitch (3)**

1) **Shannon & Storr's Brenndarcy Dreamer** Red, pleasing profile with a lovely head, well laid shoulders, good topline, tailset & rear quarters. Presented in a tight jacket. Steady mover.

1) **Thomas' Ch Tycadno Winter Star** Very confident wheaten feminine throughout with a beautiful head, correct front & rear angulation with a good topline. So sound on the move. Excellent coat. Challenged hard for the CC. **RCC**
